Baum paragraph

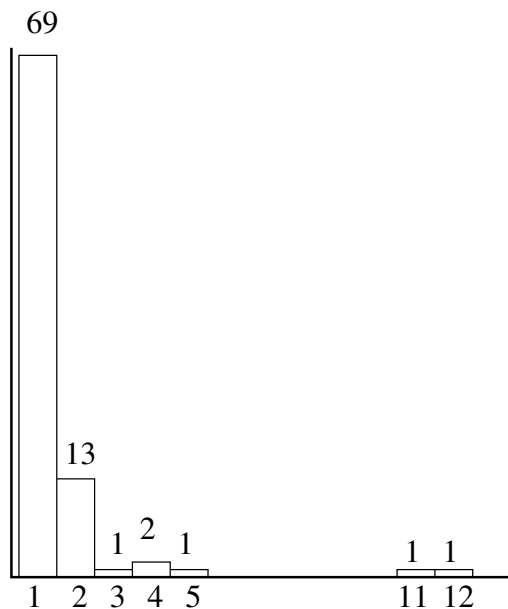
