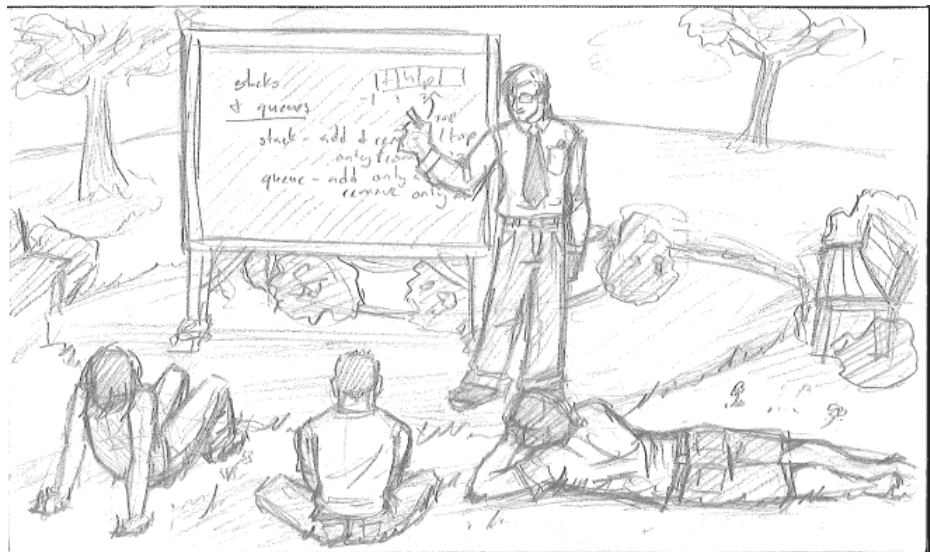

ordering	LIFO	FIFO
metaphor	Pez dispenser, stack of plates or books	Line of people
operations	push pop top (element, peek) is empty is full	add (offer) remove (poll) front (element, peek) is empty is full
applications	Palindrome testing, reversal, anything with nested structure	worklist, print queue

# Chiasmus

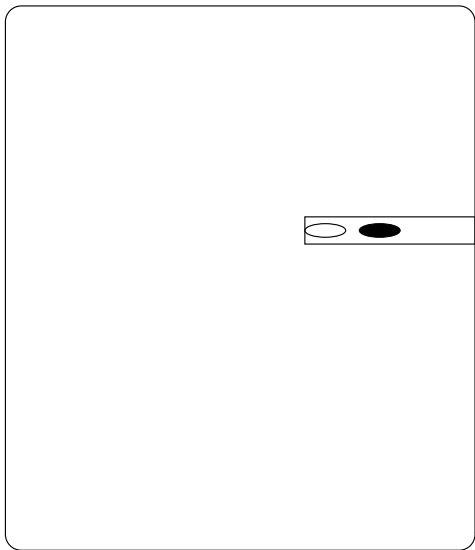
Then the steward said within himself, What shall I do? for my lord taketh away from me the stewardship: **I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed.**

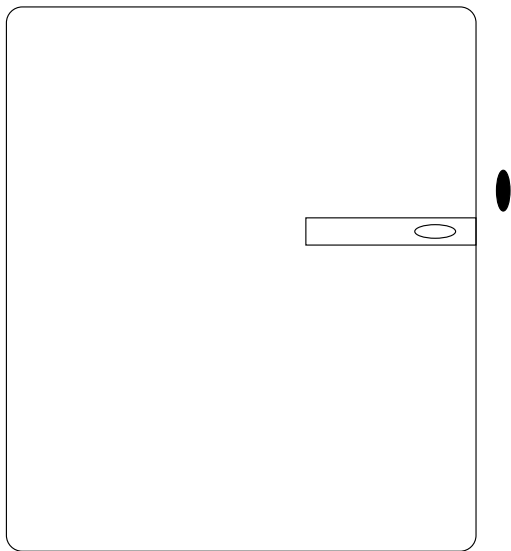
## Nested sentences
